What's available in the DBC?

- ◆ .DBC structure
- ◆ Types of records
- ◆ Relationships between records

DBC Limitations

- ◆ Some info in DBF, not DBC
- ◆ Some info used one-time only
- ◆ Renumbering of record keys limits extensibility
- ◆ Proprietary indexes

What's missing from the DBC

- ◆ Structural Information
- ◆ User Extensions

How do we get there?

- ◆ **Modify the structure of the DBC**
- ◆ **Add information to the User field**
- ◆ **Add information to a separate table**
