Top Ten Conceptual Hurdles

- 1. Everything's a file
- 2. Directory contents
- 3. Case sensitivity
- 4. Root matters
- 5. You don't have to compile everything
- 6. There's no registry
- 7. You don't have to reboot
- 8, You don't have to reinstall

Top Ten Conceptual Hurdles

- 9. Security has to be addressed
- 10. You have a choice
- 11. It can be free, but it probably won't be

Fox and Linux Scenarios

- 1. Fox apps developed on Linux, deployed on Windows
- 2. Fox apps developed on Linux, deployed on Linux
- 3. Talk to native data
- 4. Talk to external backends (Linux or Windows)
